

Jacques Mayencourt was born in Sion (Canton of Valais). He attends the class of Tibor Varga at the Music Academy of Detmold (Germany). From 1982 to 1985, he was the assistant of Tibor Varga and obtains his alto virtuosity in 1985, then a concert licence in 1987, each "summa cum laude".

Since 1989, he is the first solo alto of the Staatsphilharmonie Rheinland-Pfalz Orchester. J. Mayencourt is in charge of courses at the Mannheim Academy since 1992 and he also gives various interpretation courses.

Soloist and chamber musician with an intense international activity, he is member of several ensembles: the ABC Trio and the ensemble Huberman amount others. Jacques Mayencourt illustrates also himself as organizer of high-level concerts, as artistic director of the Association music and wine (Chamoson, Valais).

He is also Member of the artistic committee of the famous Tibor Varga International Violin Competition (Martigny, Valais) that is distinguished in the aura of the well-known virtuoso.
